Juniors may enter any section for which they are eligible but points from only one age range will count towards the trophy for most points in the Junior sections.

NB Age of juniors must be stated on the label.

Entries are the responsibility of the exhibitor. They must be in the marquee by 9.30am and only removed **between 4pm and 4.30pm.**

Prize money and rosettes must be collected by the exhibitor by 4.30pm

Any prize money not uplifted by this time will be returned to the show funds.
