

Latheron Show Saturday 11th 2026 Exhibitor Information

There is plenty to look forward to at this year's Latheron Show, held at West Clyth Farm, just North of Lybster. Following on from a great 100th show last year and with good numbers of livestock and horse entries this year we hope that this show will be just as good, if not better. We appreciate the time and hard work that goes into show preparation and are looking forward to seeing everyone on Saturday 11th. Thank you for your entries and for supporting our show.

Entry with Livestock & Horses

The showfield will be open from 7.30am on Saturday morning. Please head to the main gate, where you will be met by an entry steward and directed to the relevant animal areas for unloading. New rules mean only livestock will be permitted entry to the showfield. Horses and poultry go in the main gate and turn left, all other exhibitors follow signage and head to their respective sections. Please allow for queuing at the sheep lines. MV check area will be signposted separately.

Please remember to bring all relevant paperwork with you: Passports, MV/CAE forms and Movement licenses. No paperwork no entry.

Livestock: **Passports to be handed in to the portacabin upon arrival** on showfield, BVD status will be checked prior to unloading. Cattle numbers will be issued once checks are complete. Cattle **MUST** be double tagged.

Sheep: Once on the showfield, please follow the signs to the relevant Non-MV/MV areas. **MV forms must be submitted to sheep steward on arrival** and prior to unloading. All sheep must be electronically tagged; movements are the responsibility of the exhibitor. Numbers will be issued following checks.

Horses: Passports must accompany the animal to the show. Dedicated horsebox parking is located on the left above the eventing rings, please follow the allocated parking signs to ensure the safety of horses and livestock moving to the judging rings. Numbers can be collected from horse stewards.

Goats: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to report the show moves.

Judging Information

Cattle judging will commence at 10am and classes will follow order in the catalogue. You must have your animal ready for judging in good time and livestock number displayed. Stewards will be in the Main Ring for help if required.

Sheep/Goat judging will commence at 10am, full biosecurity procedures will be observed by the judges and stewards. Hand wash facilities, sanitiser and footbaths must be adhered to when working in those areas.

Pigs judging will commence at 11am, please follow biosecurity rules and ensure gates are secured at all times.

Poultry - Poultry Keepers must take their vehicle directly to the allocated parking behind the Poultry Marquee (please follow the signs on the showfield) . Birds must remain in your vehicle until you have spoken to the Poultry Steward, they will then be permitted entry into the marquee and to your allocated pens. Please follow the guidance included with your schedule. Full biosecurity must be adhered to at all times. Further info given on the day.

Any Egg entries can be taken to the Home Industries Tent once your birds are in their competition cages.

Pet Show Please make your way to the Pet Marquee, make yourself known to the Rabbit/ Pet Show Steward, they will have pens and show areas allocated for you. Please ensure you bring your own animal fed/water source. Animals must remain in their carriers until seen by the steward.

Horse Judging: **Highland Ponies** Judging starts at 9am followed by **Shetlands** then **Clydesdales**. **In-hand light legged** judging starts at 10am with Class 22 - Mountain & Moorlands then follows catalogue order. **Show Jumping** classes start at 11am with lead rein. Ridden & Working Hunter also commence at 9am

Competitor numbers to be picked up at the Secretary's portacabin from 7.30am. Catalogues will be available from the Secretary's portacabin on the show field on Friday evening 5pm-9pm.
